The video includes parades at The Cenotaph in central London on Remembrance Sunday and interviews with members of the Armed Forces and the general public on why they think it is important to remember the sacrifice made by others to preserve our freedoms. The video ends with a solemn reminder that Remembrance isn't just about the past - it's also about learning from history so that we can continue to preserve peace for future generations.
