What is Bullying?

**Anti-Bullying Alliance's Definition:**

The repetitive, intentional hurting of one person or group by another person or group, where the relationship involves an imbalance of power. Bullying can be physical, verbal or psychological.

It can happen face to face or online.

Our children then shared their thoughts on a video in which children from across the country gave their opinions and shared their knowledge on bullying. We answered the following questions:

-  **What was the message in the film?**
-  **How can we show respect to each other in school?**
-  **Should we be showing respect to everyone?**

The children then shared who they could turn to in school if they had worries they wanted to share.
