

## **Audition Information Sheet 2025**



## **Eligibility**

Applicants should be:

- Between 11 (starting secondary school in September 2025 as a minimum) and 18 years old.
- Resident in Leeds, or attending school or college in Leeds

Important: please note CLYM groups are subsidised by ArtForms. ArtForms funding is intended for Leeds children, therefore:

- A place will **only** be offered to an applicant who is NOT resident or attending school within Leeds Metropolitan Area if it has not been filled by a qualified applicant from within Leeds.
- Any CLYM place granted to an applicant from outside Leeds will be subject to review: they will have to re-apply each year and may lose their place to a qualified applicant from within Leeds.

## Auditions for City of Leeds Youth Orchestra and City of Leeds Youth Wind Orchestra

Date and time (you will be contacted to confirm your slot)

Saturday 14th and Sunday 15th June 2025

Audition slots will be allocated to you on a first come, first served basis – we will try to accommodate requests for particular time slots, but this cannot be guaranteed. If you are unable to attend on these dates, or if there is high demand for audition slots, we will be in touch to arrange an alternative audition for you.

What to prepare

Applicants should prepare two short contrasting pieces/sections with a total playing time of 8 minutes. Please choose pieces you enjoy playing, that are well within your capabilities. You will also be asked to sight-read a short excerpt during the audition.

**Accompanists** 

One piece **must be accompanied**, and the second piece played unaccompanied. If you wish to use the ArtForms accompanist, you must include a copy of the piano part with your application. (This can be a photocopy, but you must bring the original part to your audition.) You may bring your own accompanist if you prefer.

On the day

You will have the opportunity to warm-up for 15 minutes before your audition. Please bring along a copy of your both pieces (the piano score if possible; photocopies are acceptable) for the auditioners to see. You will play your accompanied piece first, and the audition will finish with the orchestral excerpt. The audition will take about 15 minutes in total.

## Deadline to apply is Friday 16th May 2025, 5pm.

Applications received after this deadline will be dependent on availability. If we have not received the piano part for your piece by this deadline, an accompanist cannot be guaranteed and you will need to provide your own.
