Question mark (comes at the end of a direct question, eg. Do you like dogs?)

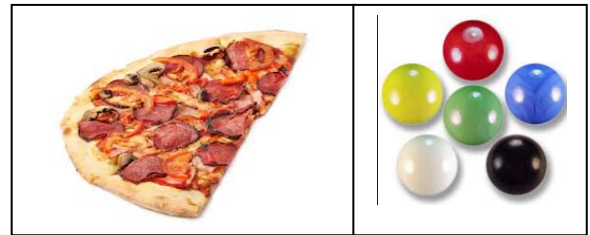


Exclamation mark (at the end of a sentence to show strong feelings, eg. Surprise!)
