### Jobs and Shops



Shopkeeper- works in a shop, often on the tills or stacking shelves.



Butcher- works in a butchers cutting up and selling meat.



Fishmonger- sells fresh fish.



Greengrocer- sells fruit and vegetables.



Iron monger- works in a shop selling metal irons, metal door handles, metal buckets.



Baker-works in a bakery making bread and pastries.



Grocer- works in a grocery shop, selling lots of everyday items eg, milk, bread, food.

#### The World



A Globe- shows the world and can turn.



The Equator- an imaginary line that divides the world into a Northern Hemisphere and Southern Hemisphere.



Continent- a very large land mass. There are 7 continents; North America, South America, Europe, Asia, Africa, Australasia and Antarctica



Ocean- a large area of water. We have the Pacific Ocean, Atlantic Ocean, Southern Ocean, Indian Ocean and the Artic Ocean.



River- a natural stream of water in a channel, leading to the sea or a lake



Mountain- a large piece of land that has a peak.
