



Maths


Key aspects of the year 4 curriculum;

- Place Value understanding the value of digits up to 10,000
- Addition and subtraction of 4 digit numbers
- Multiplication and division- multiplying up to 3 digit numbers by 1 digit numbers
- Measurement length, perimeter, area, money, time
- Fractions improper, equivalents, number lines and adding and subtracting
- Decimals linking to fractions, tenths and hundredths
- Geometry shape, position and direction (co-ordinates)
- Statistics interpreting charts and line graphs
- Fluency problems, followed by reasoning and problem solving in each lesson
- Times tables vital to aid with all maths teaching


